Lisa's Story...

"I was born as a result of my
mother having an affair with a
married man.

As a child I lived in a state
of constant uncertainty and
loneliness.

My mum had relationships that

were violent and abusive and
as a result of that at the age
six I was drugged and sexually
molested.

I learned at a very early age
that no one would protect me
and that I would have to do it
myself.

Over the years my search for
acceptance found me living the
very life I didn't want- drugs and
alcohol, parties and violence
and many years of abuse
from numerous dysfunctional
relationships.

I grew up to have no self-worth
or esteem.

After years of being a stripper
at Gold Coast clubs, the use
of drugs and alcohol in my life
also found me pregnant at age
twenty, giving birth to a son who
was diagnosed with autism. My
children now experience the
same fears and uncertainty I did
as a child.

With no one left to turn to, I
was told about Transformations
where I discovered God and I
thought why not give God a go?

Through the program I have
learned to value myself and to
know that I am loved beyond
measure, that my life does have
a purpose- a HOPE that I never
knew existed. My HOPE is in
God. He is my protector and I'm
finally safe."

Palm Beach

Beachside Transformations is a private residence in a quiet street south of the Gold Coast in Palm Beach, giving ten males at any given time an opportunity for recovery from addiction. Beachside Transformations is passionate about creating a real home environment for their residents. Brisbane

Hervey Bay
